

Notice to Consumers

On 9 January 2024, Shizen Inc. filed before the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) an Application dated 16 May 2023, entitled “In the Matter of the Authority to Develop, Own, Operate, and Maintain Dedicated Point-To-Point Limited Facilities to Connect to the Transmission System of the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP),” docketed as ERC Case No. 2024-002 MC.

The Application was filed to comply with the requirements of Republic Act No. 9136, also known as the *Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001* (EPIRA), its Implementing Rules and Regulations, as well as the relevant rules and regulations of the ERC.

Any person with an interest in the subject matter may become a party by filing with the Commission, via the same e-mail addresses, a verified Petition to Intervene at least five (5) calendar days prior to the date of the initial virtual hearing and subject to the requirements under Rule 9 of the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Likewise, all other persons who may want their views known to the Commission with respect to the subject matter of the case may file through e-mail to the same e-mail addresses their Opposition or Comment at least five (5) calendar days prior to the initial virtual hearing, pursuant to the ERC Revised Rules of Practice and Procedure and Notice of Virtual Hearing dated 19 January 2024.
